Dear Governor Chiles:

This is to advise you of my disappointment in the state of Florida's decision to reduce appropriations to Florida Civil Air Patrol (CAP).

Florida has an obligation to support CAP emergency services and should renew these monies at once. Chapter 252, F.S. mandates a total of \$55,000 per year for the CAP. The reductions cannot support all the training operations and emergency support provided by Florida Civil Air Patrol.

Please use your influence to have the Department of Community Affairs/ Department of Emergency Management, correct this injustice.

ECI - All applications for ECI courses MUST come through FL WG TTN office - refer to FL WG Supplement 1 dated 1 Sept 1991 & comply!

TRAINING REPORTS, upon completion of Level I, Squadron Leadership School and Corporate Learning Course, go to WING HQ TTN, **NOT to National HQ!** Reports MUST be sent in to WG HQ within two weeks after completion, completely filled out (typewritten) with critiques and expense vouchers included.

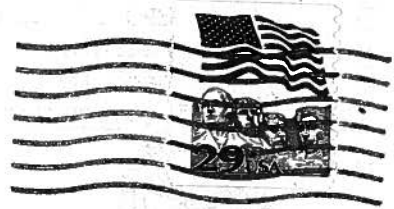
